<b>CAREER HISTORY</b>	Ashraf completed his LLB Hons in 2012 with a 2.1 grade. The following year, he qualified as a Barrister of England and Wales at the age of 21 after completing his Bar Professional Training Course from Manchester Metropolitan University with “Very Competence” grade. Subsequently, he got enrolled as an advocate of Bangladesh and practiced as a lawyer for a year. Later, in 2014, he started his LLM specialising in International Commercial Law at the University of Nottingham that he eventually passed with “Distinction” grade. He gained accreditation as a Mediator from the Centre for Effective Dispute Resolution (CEDR) in 2014. He resumed practice in Bangladesh for a year between 2015 and 2016 before starting his PhD in Law at the University of Nottingham with full scholarship having received the Vice Chancellor’s Scholarship for Research Excellence (International) and the School of Law Scholarship. The title of his research project is “Public Procurement in Bangladesh: a critical analysis of the supplier review system in the light of international standards.” In 2017, he attained the license to practice as an advocate at the Supreme Court of Bangladesh, High Court Division and became a member of the Supreme Court Bar Association in 2018.
