



Online Certificate course on 'Introduction to International Commercial Arbitration' Jointly organized by

Bangladesh International Arbitration Centre (BIAC) and Chartered Institute of Arbitrators (CIArb)

The Chartered Institute of Arbitrators (CIArb) with the support of Bangladesh International Arbitration Centre (BIAC) will be conducting the Introduction to International Arbitration Course in Singapore on 18 November 2020.

BIAC's Profile

BIAC is Bangladesh's first and only Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) institution. It is registered as a not-for-profit organization and commenced operation in April 2011. International Chamber of Commerce-Bangladesh

(ICC-B), the World Business Organization and two prominent business Chambers of Bangladesh, namely, Dhaka Chamber of Commerce & Industry (DCCI) and Metropolitan Chamber of Commerce & Industry (MCCI), Dhaka are sponsors of BIAC. BIAC's core activities include providing facilities for arbitration and mediation and organizing training and awareness programmes. It published its Arbitration and Mediation Rules in 2011 and 2014 respectively which has been replaced by the update Rules of 2019. BIAC has a Panel of Arbitrators and List of Mediators. Apart from facilitating arbitration and mediation, BIAC has got recognition by signing co-operation agreement with 17 international ADR centres for excellence in the region and 25 Banks, corporate and financial institutions, NGO and Universities in Bangladesh. The Chairman of the BIAC Board is Mr. Mahbubur Rahman, while the Chief Executive Officer is Mr. Muhammad A. (Rumee) Ali.

CIArb's Profile
